After School Club..... Our after school club for pupils is underway again. Sessions start at 3.05pm each day and children are welcome to stay until 6.00pm. The cost of each session is £5.50. If you would like to use this facility please book and pay in advance at the school office.

Medicines in School

Like all schools we need to have a clear policy on keeping medicines. For this reason I would like all parents to know exactly what procedures are in place here at Angel Road Infants. Apart from asthma inhalers we would not usually keep any medicines on site unless pupils need to take it four times a day or more. There are a limited number of exceptions such as Eczema creams which help to make sufferers more comfortable during the school day.



Late Arrival and Attendance

I am very concerned that a small minority of parents failed to regularly send their child to school on time last year whilst others also kept children at home without any real need to do so. This year we will be introducing a strict policy on late arrival and unnecessary absence.

Arriving late has become for one or two families a regular occurrence that they feel is acceptable and doesn't really matter. As a school we are closely monitored by the local authority who will regularly collect from us a list of pupils who have arrived late or who have a pattern of taking absence when there has been no real need.

Once a family have been identified as causing attendance problems they will be visited by an officer of the local authority who will make the consequences of late arrival and poor attendance clear. Action will be taken against families who fail to comply with an agreed attendance target or who still persist in delivering pupils to school late.

To the vast majority of families who always get their children here on time and who ensure they attend regularly a huge thank you.

At the end of last term over 30 pupils received attendance awards for not having a days absence all term. Some even received special awards for not having a single days absence or lateness all year!!
